Assuming you are on linux:

```
wget -E -H -k -K -p url_goes_here
```

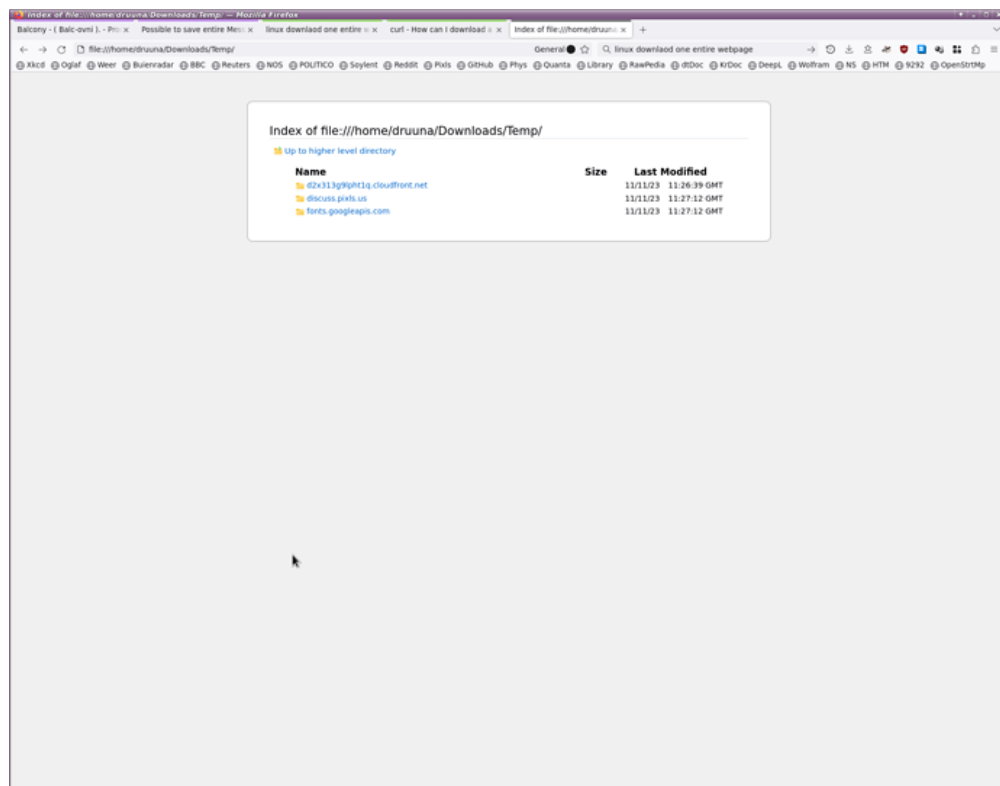

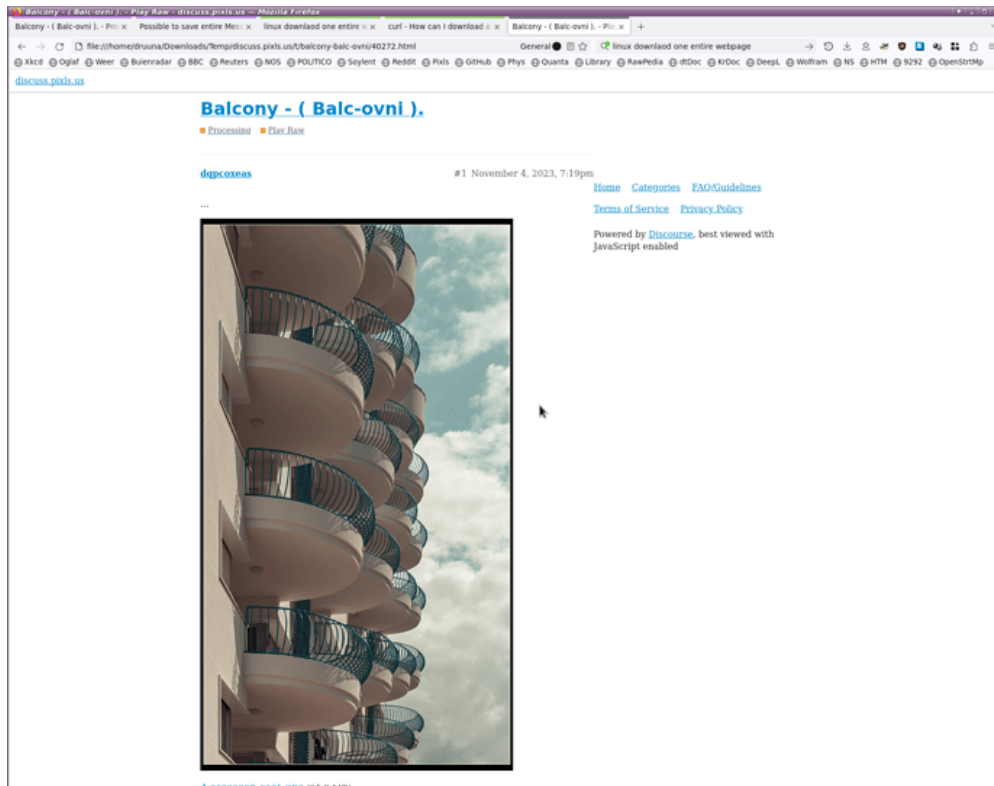

Not sure how to do that.

You would need to log in first using `wget` and the login page, save all the cookie stuff and other session data before fetching the PM thread using that cookie/session data as a reference.

Logging in shouldn't be too hard (using `wget --user=user_name --password='pwd' url` or `post-data 'name/password'`), the rest would need to use `save-cookie/save-session/load-cookie` (from the top of my head), but I'm not familiar enough with how to do that. Maybe have a look on-line and/or in the `wget` man-page.

Just did a quick on-line search (using: *wget using login*): There are enough examples out there that might help you to figure it out.
